



INTERNATIONAL ADULT TEAM QUALIFICATION 2019

1. Points will be awarded on pin fall in a sliding scale in every league event with the highest male pin fall and female pin fall gaining 1st 100, 2nd 95, 3rd 90, 4th 85, 5th 84 and so on moving on a sliding scale in increments of 1 point from 4th place. The same points based scale will be used in all league and tournament play.
2. In order to gain National League points each player must bowl a full block (i.e. full number of games allocated to that week). If a player plays more than once in a venue the highest points awarded will count for that venue. If a player fails to play in a venue, zero points will be awarded for that venue. There are 3 venues this year.
3. The three highest points gained will count towards selection if all 4 Adult tournaments. (Nationals, Doubles, AMF World Cup, Scottish Open) are bowled.
4. Doubles - points will be awarded where you finished individually after the first round. Nationals - points will be awarded where you finish in the All-events. Scottish Open and AMF WCQ - points will be awarded where you finish in the tournament including re-entries. (More details in tournament entry forms).
5. Team selection will be based on ranking finish. (i.e. 6-person team event will be top 6 in rankings, if any are unable to attend then 7th will be asked and so on).
6. If dispensation is required for any event, this will be discussed by the board on an individual basis.
7. Winners of the Masters will represent Scotland at ECC.
8. Winners of the AMF WCQ will represent Scotland at AMF World Cup.
9. Players must make themselves available for Squad Training Sessions.
10. All players will Sign and Accept the Terms of Reference.
