Each bowler will be awarded merit points for each tournament towards a merit points prize on completion of tour.

Minimum of 4 tournaments must be bowled to be eligible for a merit prize

Tournament Rules

- 1 The General Playing and Tournament Rules of the WTBA will govern the tournaments.
- 2 No person may play in this tournament except those originally entered. Replacements may be authorised by Tournament Director upon request.
- 3 This is a handicapped tournament with handicaps being based on difference of 66% and 220 from the individuals' current SSTC average
- 4 For the first tournament entry of an individual to the tour handicaps shall be based on current league average. Where an individual has no current average then they shall be handicapped retrospectively on completion of their tournament games.
- 5 Thereafter for the individuals second and subsequent entry to the tour handicaps shall be based on their previous tour games.
- 6 A provisional ball must be rolled if a dispute relating to pinfall cannot be immediately resolved.
- 7 Protests must be lodged verbally within 15 minutes of any infraction and confirmed in writing within 72 hours to the tournament manager.
- 8 Bowlers must register for their squad 30 minutes prior to squad start time.
- 9 Dress code will be attire suitable for bowling. The wearing of head gear, vest tops will not be permitted to bowl. Tailored knee length shorts may be permitted for men.
- 10 All rosin/powder must be wiped from the surface of the ball before bowling. Balls are not to be resurfaced during play. Any bowler infracting this rule will receive a verbal warning; subsequent infractions will result in disqualification.
- 11 All bowlers must be aged 45 years or over on the day of the tournament.
- 12 The Tournament Director is Mrs Louise Gillespie or her nominated deputy.
- 13 **Payment on the day of the tournament will not be accepted.**

- 14 Format shall be 6 games bowled in 3 blocks of 2 games changing lanes after each block
- 15 Proof of average must be supplied before the tournament – copy of current league average to be supplied with entry form for first SSTC tournament
- 16 Scores and handicaps will be verified before payment of prize monies.

The tour will consist of 5 tournaments..

Merit table, Merit points shall be awarded on handicap scores from each tournament.

A minimum of 4 tournaments must be bowled to be eligible for merit table prize.

If all 5 tournaments are bowled then the 4 tournaments with the highest merit points shall be utilised for the final merit table.

Prize funds for each tournament shall be awarded on handicapped pinfall.

Prize funds for each tournament and merit table shall be awarded pro rata between male and female based on the number of entries.

Total prize fund for each tournament shall be divided 50% between the tournament prize fund and the merit prize fund.

Entry Fees shall be £40 per tournament.

Prize fund element shall be £15 and £5 per bowler to STB senior fund.

Once all entries have been paid any surplus after deducting £15 prize fund, senior fund and centre lineage charges shall be paid into prize fund. This surplus shall be divided 50% to tournament prize fund and 50% to merit fund.
